Pay Plan Increase Begins in September

After reviewing our current pay plan, the Piedmont Triad Regional Council consultants recommended the job rate for all job classifications in the pay plan be raised. The City Council approved a 2.5% pay increase for all employees in the FY2018-2019 Budget. This increase will take effect on 9/1/18 for the semi-monthly payroll, and 9/2/18 for the bi-weekly payroll. It will show up in paychecks on 9/15/18 for semi-monthly and 9/21/18 for biweekly. The budget also includes monies for the next phase of the PTRC market analysis, which will begin in late winter/early spring 2019.
