Building Maintenance Mechanic I

(Facilities Maintenance Department)

An employee in this class performs skilled work in general maintenance and repair of buildings, plumbing, carpentry, HVAC and electrical installation, and may perform semi-skilled tasks in other building trades. The employee in this class will receive work assignments from a superior in terms of the job to be accomplished and its location. The employee usually works independently in performing assigned tasks, but refers unusual work problems to a supervisor for consideration or inspection. Work is reviewed by supervisors through observation, periodic conferences and by inspecting completed work. The building maintenance workforce should always include someone with extensive experience and/or a license in each of the building specialties – plumbing, electricity, welding, carpentry and HVAC.

Minimum Experience and Training:

Graduation from an accredited high school. Experience in performing tasks in the construction, maintenance and repair of buildings, facilities and equipment or an equivalent combination of experience and training.

Special Requirement:

Must possess a valid North Carolina driver's license and have a safe driving record.

Physical Requirements:

Must be able to lift and carry 75 to 100 pounds. Must be able to climb, crawl, and crouch. Will sometimes work in high places. Is exposed to electrical current. Will work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
