Building Maintenance Mechanic III

(Facilities Maintenance Department)

An employee in this class performs very skilled, certified and licensed work in the general maintenance, construction and repair of buildings, plumbing, carpentry, HVAC and electrical installation.

The primary focus is the installation, repair and maintenance of all types of HVAC/R equipment at various facilities. An employee in this class must also apply supervision, preventive maintenance, diagnostic and trade skills to a variety of construction, maintenance and repair problems. Assignments are of the nature that may require work performance at a licensed or journeyman level in more than one building trade skill. Employee works independently in performing assigned tasks. Work usually involves the supervision of employees engaged in semi-skilled work and may involve the supervision of skilled employees. Work is evaluated by superiors through observation, periodic conferences and by inspection of completed work. The building maintenance workforce should always include someone with extensive experience and/or a license in each of the building specialties – plumbing, electricity, welding, and carpentry.

Minimum Experience and Training:

Graduation from an accredited high school or General Educational Development (GED) equivalency. Minimum of five years of HVAC experience with the knowledge and experience to layout, install, maintain and repair various HVAC systems, including boilers. North Carolina Heating License preferred or equivalent hours in HVAC to qualify for NC Plumbing and Heating Board exam. Must be EPA certified to handle refrigerants.

Special Requirement: Must possess a valid North Carolina driver's license and have a safe driving record.

Physical Requirements:

Must be able to lift and carry 75 to 100 pounds. Must be able to climb, crawl, and crouch. Sometimes works in high places on scaffolding, ladders, man lifts, etc. Will be exposed to electrical current. Ability to work in all weather conditions required.
