Minimum Experience and Training

Graduation from an accredited high school. Experience in plumbing maintenance and /or construction tasks or an equivalent combination of experience and training.

Special Requirements

Must possess a valid North Carolina driver's license and have a safe driving record.

Incumbent will be required to adhere to the "on-call" practices and procedures followed by the Water/Sewer Maintenance Department.

Must be able to work overtime on short notice.
