This special meeting has been called in order to allow the Asheboro City Council, with the assistance of city staff members, to conduct a public informational meeting on the question of statutorily annexing approximately 80.317 acres of land located in the area of Sherwood Avenue southwest of West Dixie Drive and US Highway 220 Bypass. At this public informational meeting, plans for extending municipal services to the area proposed for annexation will be explained, and all residents and property owners in said territory along with all residents of the City of Asheboro will be given an opportunity to ask questions and receive answers regarding the proposed annexation.

All officers of the city and all other persons whomsoever are hereby given notice that such meeting will be held.

This notice is issued on this 20th day of April, 2006 by order of Mayor David H. Jarrell and pursuant to the laws of the State of North Carolina and the City of Asheboro relative to the time and place of holding meetings, both regular and special, of the Asheboro City Council.

A quorum thus being present, Mayor Jarrell called the meeting to order for the transaction of business, and business was transacted as follows:

Mayor Jarrell welcomed everyone in attendance and turned the meeting over to Mr. Ogburn for an explanation of the annexation report previously approved by the City Council that details how the area proposed for annexation meets the statutory standards for annexation and how all municipal services provided by the City of Asheboro will be extended to the area proposed for annexation as of the effective date of the annexation. Said annexation would be effective as of June 30, 2007.

During his presentation, Mr. Ogburn utilized a power point slide presentation. A hard copy of this power point presentation is on file in the City Clerk's office and is incorporated into these minutes by reference.

At the conclusion of Mr. Ogburn's presentation, Mayor Jarrell opened the meeting for questions from the public. Mr. David Lewallen, and Mr. John Hunt expressed certain questions in regards to street maintenance, while Mr. and Mrs. Danny Hicks expressed concerns in regards to water meters. The public had also been invited to ask questions during Mr. Ogburn's presentation.

Citizens may express comments and concerns in regards to the proposed annexation at a public hearing that will be held on Thursday, May 18, 2006. An ordinance to extend the corporate limits of the City of Asheboro will be presented to the City Council for adoption on June 8, 2006.

Other than conducting this public informational meeting, no formal action was taken by the City Council.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
