

# **NEW ORDINANCE**

**ANTI-TETHERING ORDINANCE WILL GO INTO EFFECT  
STARTING JANUARY 1, 2017**



This is a Public Announcement: The Asheboro City Animal Control Ordinance is changing next year. Effective January 1, 2017 the tethering or chaining of dogs will no longer be allowed in the City of Asheboro. Residents have until January 1, 2017 to find another way of keeping dogs on their property.

## **EXCEPTIONS:**

- Citizens may tether a dog for a reasonable period of time to allow for bathroom breaks
- Citizens may tether a dog on a runner for a reasonable period of time that allows the dog to exercise
