Animal Control Officer

(Police Department)

An employee in this class receives and responds to citizen requests for service and captures, confines, and if necessary, dispatches severely injured animals. Tact and courtesy are required in sensitive public contact situations in explaining animal control laws to animal owners. Work is performed in accordance with city/county ordinances and state laws governing animal control and requires some independent judgment and initiative in application of the laws. Employee is subject to the usual hazards of animal control work. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Animal Control Supervisor in accordance with state and city regulations.

Minimum Experience and Training

Graduation from an accredited high school or have attained a G.E.D. Employee should be proficient in the use of a shotgun and rifle. Experience working with animals is preferred.

Special Requirements

Must possess a valid North Carolina driver's license and have a safe driving record. Must qualify annually on the use of a shotgun and rifle. Incumbent will be required to adhere to the "on-call" practices and procedures followed by the Police Department.

Physical Requirements

Must be able to lift and carry 75 to 100 pounds independently. Must be able to climb, crawl, stretch, and kneel. Works outdoors in varying weather conditions.
